

Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement

For the purposes of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 (“the Act”), Aeromet International Limited (“Aeromet”) makes the following statement:

Aeromet is a UK based company. Our main activity is the manufacturing of precision castings from aluminium and magnesium alloy, which is undertaken at 3 UK sites.

Aeromet’s supply chain is mostly located in the UK and is not extensive. Our major supply agreements are for casting alloy which is sourced entirely within the UK, and foundry consumables which are sourced from companies within the UK, North America or Western Europe. Other suppliers are also mostly UK based specialist suppliers covering areas such as IT hardware, recruitment agencies, calibration specialists, equipment rental and maintenance, auditors and banking and insurance service providers.

To minimise the risk of modern slavery occurring within the Aeromet manufacturing and supply chain, the following further actions have been taken:

- An Anti-Slavery Policy has been published across all Aeromet sites.
- Our supply chain team engages directly with suppliers in respect of our anti-slavery policy in order to gain a proper understanding of the measures in place to ensure modern slavery is not occurring within their own businesses and supply chains.
- Our contractual documentation will continue to be amended, where possible, to incorporate specific prohibition against slavery or servitude, the use of forced, compulsory or trafficked labour and the use of child labour in line with this policy. We will also look to make provision for our contracted suppliers to hold their own suppliers to the same standards.

We will continue to update this Modern Slavery Statement annually to share our developing approach to this important governance area.
